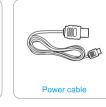

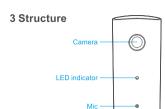

3.2 LED indicator status

4 Operation

4.1 Connect with power

- 1. Connect with the power cable and charger
- 2. The Blue LED indicator will be fashing slowly if the device is connected successfully with the WIFI network. If the Blue LED is constant on, it means the WIFI network is not set correctly or there is no WIFI, and it will enter into AP setting mode. (NOTE: AP means Access Point, also known as "Hot Spot",in this mode, the phone connects with the Camera directly without Ethernet connection.)

4.2 Fast setting

4.2.1 APP

Please download APP "Jimilivepro" from APP store or at Google Play.

4.2.2 WIFI setting

- 1)When device blue LED is constant on, please go to your phone's wifi setting and connect to an available network.
- 2)Start APP on your phone, create account and login.

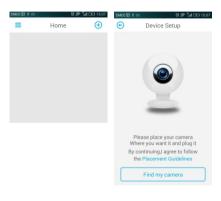
NOTE: For iOS device, after successful login, press home button and go to the phone's wifi setting, find the connection name "JH08_XXXXXX" and input password "88888888". After that, please go back to the APP.

3)Enter "Home" page. A dialog will prompt, indicating necessary version upgrade. Click "OK" to start update. Click "cancel" to remove the dialog that will appear twice daily.

Select your camera and start setup.



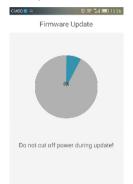
5)Personalize the environment of the camera





6)Click camera to enter Live-monitor page; Check the camera firmware; A dialog will prompt if there is necessary firmware update. Click "next time" to remove the dialog that will appear twice daily. Click "update" to start the process.





7)Click camera to enter Live-monitor; Press "Hold to Talk" to talk to the camera; Click % to turn ON/OFF voice monitor; Click to take a snapshot; Click to take video manully;

Click

to check alerting report, video and snapshot;

Click to share the camera to another account.

Double click the screen or click to switch screen orientation.





8)Press and hold the screen to unbind the target camera. Unbinding the camera will ask for account and password information and restore to AP mode(direct connection between the phone and the camera, no ethernet) again. (NOTE: One device UUID can only connect with one email account, if this device UUID is already bound to an email account, it needs to be unbound manually so that it could be bound to another email account again. Unbind the camera will restore to factory setting and restart camera, to bind the camera again needs to place your phone near to the camera.)





9)Click ≡ at front page to enter the layout page. "Account" "Share" and "About" information could be checked here.



B)Change password



A)Account: Log out, change password and choose network model (Wifi-Only: Live-monitor and Playback only with available WIFI, Always: Live-monitor and Playback with WIFI or mobile network; Never: Live-monitor and Playback is never allowed.)



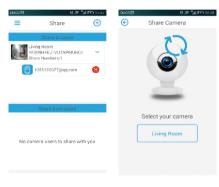
C)About: Version check and update for APP



D)Share. User can share his cameramonitoring page to other users, vise versa.

10)Click on Live-monitor page to access Album, Alarms and Fulltime video. Album includes snapshot and manual video. Alarms includes motion detection alarm and voice detection alarm. Click the video to playback.



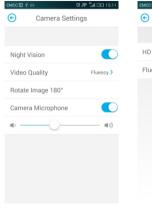
11)Click on the Live page to enter Setting page.

Off: No recording

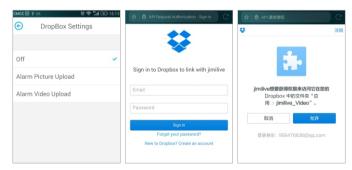

(Note: If the camera supports Night-Vision function, Manual recording will display, or you will see Full-time recordin)



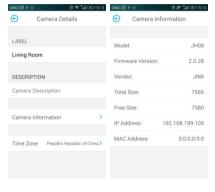

H)Format TFCard (Choose Format TF Card in Settings page)



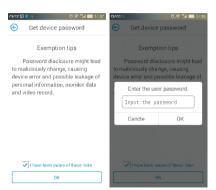

5 Installation

you can put the device on a fat surface with the magnetic base or install it on the wall or the ceiling. Details please check below:

- Notice: a. Before installation, please make sure the device is close to the power socket.
 - b. Before secure the pin and the screw, please drill holes on fat and solid surface.

5.1 Wall mount installation

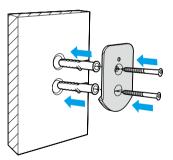
5.1.1 Remove the pin from wall mount



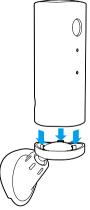
5.1.2 Drill holes

Drills holes on the wall according to the position of the pin holes.

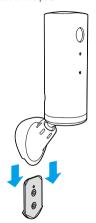
- 5.1.3 Secure the pin to the wall

5.1.4 Secure the device on the wall mount.



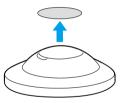
5.1.5 Secure the wall mount to the pin.



5.2 Celling installation

⚠ Notice: Please set "Video fip" in the APP's "Camera setting" if install on the ceiling, otherwise the image will be back side down.

5.2.1 Use a slot type screwdriver to take out the top cover gently and reveal the screw hole.

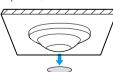


5.2.2 Drill holes on the ceiling according to position of the magnetic base.

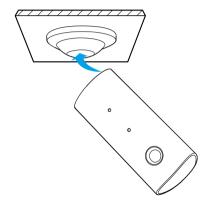
5.2.3 Secure the magnetic base onto the ceiling



5.2.4 Press back the circle top cover.
